## **3<sup>rd</sup> Montreal International Haitian Film Festival Deadline for Submitting Films Is July 3, 2007**

**Montreal, June 26, 2007-** Registration of films for the third MIHFF, which will run in Montreal from September 19 to 23, 2007, has been open since February 2007: feature-length or short fiction, documentary and animation films. The registration form, the preselection conditions and the regulations are available on the Festival website at [www.festivalfilmhaitien.com](http://www.festivalfilmhaitien.com) until the deadline, which has been set at July 2, 2007. However, given that July 2 is a holiday (Canada Day), the Festival will accept registrations, this one time only, until July 3, 2007.

Films that are not entirely finished yet may still be registered today. Simply complete the form and indicate that the DVD or VHS viewing copy of the film is pending. The deadline for receiving the films is July 12. Unregistered copies sent before July 3 will not be accepted.

Created by the Fabienne Colas Foundation, the MIHFF promotes Haitian cinema, encourages quality independent cinema and provides an opportunity for professionals from Haiti, Quebec and elsewhere to meet. This five-day event (from September 19 to 23, 2007) filled with interculturalism, entertainment and sharing will present the best and the most amazing new films in the world of Haitian cinema. Several thousands of movie-goers are expected to turn out for the 2007 edition of the Festival.
